## SARC Annual Sponsorship

Annual Sponsors have a profound impact on SARC's operating budget and ability to provide free and confidential services to victims of domestic violence, sexual violence and stalking in Harford County. Due in part to the success of last year's sponsorships, SARC provided support, advocacy and resources to over 2,000 victims; fielded 3,214 Helpline calls, provided 6,038 nights of safe shelter, offered 1,675 counseling sessions to children and adults, and gave 742 legal safety planning sessions, attended 274 attorney court proceedings and presented a myriad of outreach and educational presentations in schools and workplaces.

SARC's ability to continue to provide all of these services free of charge to family members, friends, neighbors, and colleagues in Harford County rests heavily upon the community. On behalf of the survivors served, thank you for choosing to support SARC and help us achieve our mission.

### 24-Hour Helpline

Available 365 days a year to assist those looking for help and/or resources. 410-836-8430



### Safe Housing

A confidential, trauma-informed care communal living house for those seeking escape from abuse.



### Counseling Services

For adults and children who are victims of intimate partner violence as well as case management and services for victims of sex trafficking.



### Legal Services

Legal advocacy, immigration support, and court accompaniment for victims of sexual violence, domestic violence and stalking.



### Helpline Chat

When it is unsafe to reach out by phone, chat is available on the SARC website during designated days and times.



### Community Outreach

**NICOLE** "My daughter saved my life and SARC empowered me to live it. They gave me the support and resources I needed to stay safe and begin to rebuild. I had to do the work, but the involvement from SARC and the free resources that I received helped give me the confidence to know I was capable of standing up and speaking out, and that I deserved a future free from pain."



**JANE** came to SARC after 20 years of physical, verbal, and emotional abuse from her husband that left her feeling isolated, fearful, and with low self-esteem. Frightened and frustrated about her husband's threats and refusal to sign divorce papers, Jane came to SARC in search of support and resources that would aid her in rebuilding her life. After meeting with Crisis Intervention, Jane began individual counseling where she worked on improving her self-esteem. As her self-confidence improved, Jane grew more assertive and determined to live life more fully, becoming active in community activities, building a healthy social network, and moving forward in divorce proceedings. Today, Jane is a confident woman who recognizes her strengths and abilities.



**TOM** came to SARC seeking shelter from an abusive wife. Once he was safe, he was met with someone from legal department to help him obtain information about custody of his child. He obtained this information and was given resources and referrals for out-of-state relocation. He relocated quickly to be with family and friends who supported him, the end of the abusive relationship, and healthy goals for himself and his child.
